Unexpected teachers leaving, not taking contracts, interstate staff not arriving Managing staff leave will be the next biggest challenge, minimal relief staff available Teaching staff process being run, some support staff processes currently being run as well Brigid's current focus is getting VET, WPL, WACE up and running for our Year 11s, workload is huge to ensure students have course timetabled. Also training people about the processes Issues with Skill Hire and their communication, no fault to the school **Finance** Get ESC C&C figures for 2021 to 99.3% income budgeted received compare to a like school 80.39% expenditure spent – low due to Building and works planned for 2021 but will be expended in 2022 (Stage 2 Blinds, Stage 2 bookcases, CCTV, PPP quarterly payment) Salary budget 91% spend, we have positions we want to fill but we want to ensure we get the right people for those positions 96% spend requirement between salary and cash, due to us not reaching this target in 2021 we now have additional spending on top of our 96% for 2022 • Can we do anything additional to increase voluntaries – raffle? Stephen to mock something up for Other items the newsletter to get feedback on Parking – need to keep an eye on capacity for staff and parents dropping of/collecting students Students will not be allocated parking space at this stage as we're looking at full capacity next year with just our staff
