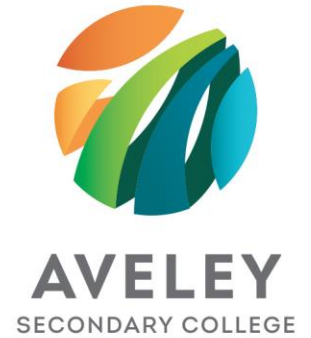


SPORTS ELITE PROGRAM

The Sports Elite Program is exclusively available to students in the Aveley Secondary College local intake area. It has been designed to maximise our talented sporty students' physical and personal development. Our vision is to promote a 'high performance culture' for students focusing on sporting excellence, creating the balance needed for students to be successful both on and off the field. The Sports Elite Program will run alongside the student's normal timetable and take place every Tuesday or Wednesday from 7.15 am to 8.15 am in the school's Sports Hall.

If your child is interested in applying for a place in the Sports Elite Program for 2025, please follow the selection process instructions below.

The selection process for the Aveley Secondary College Sports Elite Program for 2025 is comprised of two components;

Stage 1: Completion of the attached written application form which outlines your child's sporting achievement and aspirations. The application form must be submitted with your Expression of Interest for Enrolment form by 4.00pm **Friday 16 August 2024** to Aveley.SC.Enrolments@education.wa.edu.au.

Stage 2: If successful in stage 1 (written application), you will be notified via email and your child will be invited to complete a physical test based on a variety of key sport components such as strength, power, speed, agility, flexibility and aerobic fitness. This will be conducted at the College at a time and date still to be confirmed.

Students will be notified of their selection in the SEP via email after the results of the trials have been reviewed.
